



Activity 8 Alternative Activity	What should they wear? Neighbourhood safety hunt
Time	10 to 15 minutes
Participant needs	pen or pencil
Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Self-paced • small or large group
Additional Resources	

Have the participants think about all the people who work in their neighbourhood. Have the participants make a list of the jobs and the PPE they might wear.

Depending on the neighbourhood and the mobility of the participants to get around, answers to this activity may vary.

You can use the answers from other activities for some of the jobs.

Option: Use action figures doing different jobs and ask the participants what PPE the figure is wearing. You could also talk about any hazards for the job as well.



Sample answers

Job	PPE
Firefighter	Bunker gear, breathing tanks
Police	Bullet proof vests, reflective vests, boots
Ambulance	Non-slip safety shoes, gloves, reflective clothing
Nurse	Gloves, mask
Construction worker	Hard hat, safety boots, glasses, reflective clothing
Garbage collector (sanitation)	Safety boots, gloves, protective clothes
